Members discussed the draft budget and anticipated expenditure previously circulated by the Clerk. Members were conscious of the yet unknown costs for clearance drainage works to Crosby Villa Allotments, play park costs and sink holes to Birkby Village Green, potential resurfacing costs to Crosby village green, as well as the current increase in RPI. Members are aware that works will need prioritised. It was **RESOLVED** that the precept be set at £25495 - a 15% increase
